Focus Areas:

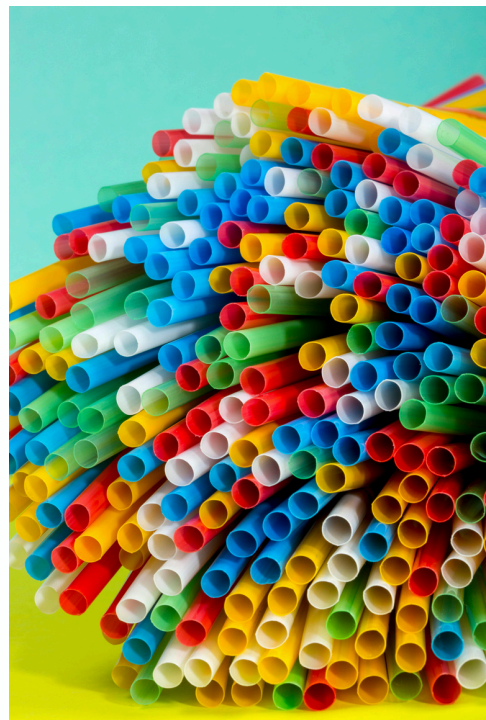
Priority is given to plastics, textiles, batteries and information technologies.
