Code of Digital Conduct

I understand I am accountable for my behavior as a digital citizen.

Responsible digital citizenship is as follows:

- I will act with integrity.
- I will demonstrate respectful behavior.
- I will protect the privacy of my personal information.
- I will report abuse or inappropriate behavior towards myself or others.
- I will not participate in cyberbullying or other aggressive or degrading activity.
- I will not visit inappropriate sites.
- I will respect the property of others, including intellectual and technological property.
- I will verify resources.
- I will avoid plagiarism by requesting permission to use resources and citing them properly.
- I will avoid participating in piracy by purchasing media and music and will refrain from distributing media in a manner that violates licensing.
