1. authority (n)	a group of people with official responsibility for a particular area of activity	εξουσία
2. deliberate (adj)	intentional or planned	σκοπίμος, εσκεμμένος
3. ritual (n)	a fixed set of actions and words, especially as part of a ceremony	τελετουργία
4. purification (n)	the act of removing harmful substances from something	εξαγνισμός
5. confiscation (n)	the act of taking something away from someone as a punishment	κατάσχεση
6. elimination (n)	the process of removing something	εξάλειψη
7. repression (n)	the use of force or violence to control a group of people	καταστολή, καταπίεση
8. subversive (adj)	trying to destroy or damage something, especially an established political system	ανατρεπτικός, υπονομευτικός
9. persecution (n)	unfair or cruel treatment over a long period of time because of race, religion, or political beliefs	δίωξη, κατατρεγμός
10. conformity (n)	behaviour that follows the usual standards that are expected by a group or society	κομφορμισμός, συμμόρφωση
11. suppress (v)	to end something by force	καταπνίγω, καταστέλλω
12. tolerance (n)	willingness to accept behaviour and beliefs that are different from your own, although you might not agree with or approve of them	ανοχή, ανεκτικότητα
13. spontaneous (adj)	happening or done in a natural, often sudden way, without any planning or without being forced	αυθόρμητος
14. (il)literate (n)	(a lack of) the ability to read and write	(ανα)λφαβητισμός
15. resist (v)	to fight against something or someone that is attacking you	αντιστέκομαι
16. consequence (n)	a result of a particular action or situation, often one that is bad or not convenient	συνέπεια
17. outdated (adj)	old-fashioned and therefore not as good or as fashionable as something modern	απαρχαιωμένος

18. intimidate (v)	to frighten or threaten someone, usually in order to persuade them to do something that you want them to do	εκφοβίζω
19. preserve (v)	to keep something as it is, especially in order to prevent it from decaying or being damaged or destroyed	διατηρώ, συντηρώ
