



**A3 paper-MAN FIGURE**

Write in the body of the figure how the person that is being bullied/cyberbullied feels.

Outside of the body, around the body, write what people say to him/her, comments made, words spoken.

Draw the face to show his/her feelings.

Colour the poster.



**A3 paper-Design a Poster**

Make a poster on bullying/cyberbullying.

Write the forms of bullying we have (verbal, social, physical, cyber).

Write what we should do as victims (e.g. who to talk to, who to call)

Write what we shouldn't do if we are the bullies.

Draw pictures. Use colours to show emotions.



Write a comic. Develop a comic strip about a bullying incident.

Divide the A3 paper into strips.

Draw figures.

Use bubbles to write the figures' lines in.

Remember the 4 types of people involved:  
Target/victim, Bully, Bystander, Upstander.

You can have a narrator, if you wish, whose lines come on the top of each strip in italics.

Remember: It's important to think about and answer these questions.

1- **Who** (is involved)

2- **What** (is happening or happened)

3- **Why** (is this happening or happened)

4- **When** (is this happening or happened)

5- **Where** (is this happening or happened)

6- **How** (is this happening or happened)
