

Simple Present Tense

Study the sentences to see how we can talk about student life in English.



I **go** to school **on** weekdays.

You **do** your homework after school.

A pupil **studies** in the afternoon

A teacher **works** in a school.

We **have** classes on weekdays.

Schools in Greece **finish** in June.

Do you go to school by school bus?

Does a teacher work on a farm?

I **don't go** to school on Sundays.

You **don't do** your homework at night.

A pupil **doesn't study** at night or in the evening.

A teacher **doesn't work** in a café.

We **don't have** classes on Sundays.

They **don't finish** in March.

Yes, I do / No, I don't.

No, he/she doesn't. He/she works at a school.

Note the different endings!

I watch - he **watches**

we teach - Helen **teaches**

you go - it **goes**

you play - she **plays**

I enjoy - he **enjoys**

they stay - it **stays**

they study - John **studies**

we carry - she **carries**

I fly - the bird **flies**
