

She bananas since she was a child. (present perfect)

She bananas for 2 hours (present perfect continuous)

Future tenses

eat a banana






(tomorrow) Be going to	(tomorrow at 2:00') Future continuous	(tomorrow at 2:05') Future perfect
 She	 She	 She

I'm sure she bananas all her life. (Future simple)

Past tenses

eat a banana



(yesterday) Be going to	(yesterday at 2:00') Past continuous	(yesterday at 2:05') Past perfect
 She	 She	 She

She more bananas when she was a kid. (past, used to)

Yesterday she didn't have dinner because she bananas all day. (past perfect continuous) (past continuous)

Present Tenses (No. 1,2, 7,8)

He (often/read) books at the weekend but today he can't read because he (cook) for his visitors.

He (make) Mexican food at the moment.

He (not/make) Mexican food before.

It's the first time he (make) Mexican food.

He (cook) since 8 in the morning.



His visitors (eat) Mexican food many times before and they are very demanding.

I (know) him for a long time and I (know) that he is a perfectionist. He (want) to satisfy his demanding friends.

That's why he is so stressed out but next week he (go) on holidays in a 5-star hotel where he can relax and forget all his worries.





Past Tenses (No. 3,4, 9,10)

He (bake) a cake yesterday.

He (not/bake) a cake before.

He (mix) the ingredients

when the telephone (ring).



The phone (ring) for 2 minutes but he (not/answer)
the phone because he (want) to put the cake in the oven first.

After he (put) the cake in the oven the phone (ring) again.

He (answer) it and he (talk) for 45' min.

when he (smell) something burning.

He (completely/forget) about the cake in the oven.





All the Tenses (+ be going to , used to)



1. Now, he (σκόπεύει) (eat) a hamburger.
2. Yesterday at 6 pm he (σκόπευε) (eat) a hamburger.
3. He often (eat) hamburgers at 6pm.
4. He (συνήθιζε) (drink) coca-cola with his burger but now he doesn't.



6:00'pm

1. Now, he (eat) a hamburger.
2. He(eat) this huge hamburger for 10 minutes.
3. Yesterday at 6:00pm he (eat) a hamburger.
4. Yesterday before that hamburger
he (eat) a pizza.



5. Tomorrow at 6:00pm he (eat) a hamburger.
6. Tomorrow, by 7:00pm he (eat) two hamburgers and a pizza!!
